Include details of how the data will be stored, how long it will be kept, whether or not there will be subsequent use of data, and whether participants will have the opportunity to consent for the subsequent use of data.
13. Description of any expected publications or plans for the information collected during research. Include a description of how any royalties would be shared with research participants.
14. Description of how results will be shared with the community.
